There has been a Lord Mayor of London since 1189. The modern Lord Mayor's procession is a direct descendant of that first journey to Westminster and the pageantry of Pepys and Canaletto is recognisable today.

The Lord Mayor's Show is a wonderful mixture of past, present and future with today's businesses, Livery Companies, Her Majesty's Forces, the City Police and Londoners from all walks of life coming together to enjoy a splendid celebration of the City's tradition and future.

Williamson's Tavern is said to hold the oldest excise licence in the City, the original tavern dates back to the 17th Century. It became a place of residence for the Lord Mayors of London.

£13 per adult includes two course lunch. £8 per child under 16. Drinks will be purchased separately on the day.

The day is as follows:

10am – meet at Williamson's Tavern (details in the left panel). Tea and coffee available, pay as you go.

11am – parade starts. We shall watch from a suitable roadside vantage point.

12.30pm – a hearty two course lunch at the tavern (see attached booking form)

Mid-afternoon – Master and Wardens join us.

5pm – Fireworks start, vantage point just near to Blackfriars bridge.
